Subject: Minutes of Meeting of District Skill Committee held on 04.02.2022 at 10 AM through video conferencing, under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner UT Chandigarh.

The list of participants is as per Annexure –A.

The following are the comprehensive points that were discussed during the District Skill Committee meeting:

1. At the outset, Research Officer, CSDM, District Education Officer, Senior Programme Officer, Department of Environment, Senior Manager LDM Chandigarh, Representative from Department of Social Welfare, Representative ALC presented the progress of their respective departments.
2. Chairman CII Chandigarh shared that according to Industry requirements, District should focus on skilling youth in E-commerce, Healthcare, and Construction and Industry 4.0 sectors. He further added that Training of Trainers in ITI should be undertaken so they can provide better training as per latest industry requirements. He also suggested that there should be a website/ portal through which industry can know/ contact the skilled manpower and also share their requirements.
3. Mahatma Gandhi National Fellow briefed about the Fellowship and role of Fellow in the District and also briefed the committee on the role and need of DSC in the district
4. Chairperson of the DSC i.e. Deputy Commissioner UT Chandigarh, reviewed the progress of all departments and appreciated the same. He stressed on the need to address the miss-match between demand and supply of manpower, need to promote entrepreneurship in the district and better coordination between different departments. He further directed CSDM team and Fellow to prepare draft DSDP for 2022-2023 by the end of Feb 2022 so that the plan could be put into action w.e.f 1.4.2022 after taking the approvals from Ministry.
5. DTE-cum-MD CSDM, shared update about progress of efforts to promote Bakery under One District One Product for Chandigarh. DTE-cum-MD CSDM backed the suggestion of creating website/ portal through which industry can know/ contact the skilled manpower and also share their requirements.
6. All departments were requested to support in preparation of District Skill Development Plan.
7. It was decided that draft of DSDP may be presented on 4th March 2022.
8. The Meeting ended with vote of thanks.
